As a qualified funeral celebrant I will work with you on creating an appropriate service that tells the story of your loved one and reflects their wishes. I have come to this role with experience in palliative care gained through writing the handbook, [Buddhist Care for the Dying](#), published in 2004 by the Buddhist Council of Victoria. This is a reference text for chaplains and carers in healthcare and elsewhere. I have given many talks on Buddhist palliative care in hospitals and other settings and can add Buddhist elements to a funeral ceremony if appropriate.

I am also a poet, broadcaster and MC. For many years I hosted poetry nights for the Melbourne Poets Union and I produce a monthly edition of the Spoken Word program on community radio 3CR.

I look forward to working with you to create a ceremony that honours the memory of your loved one.
